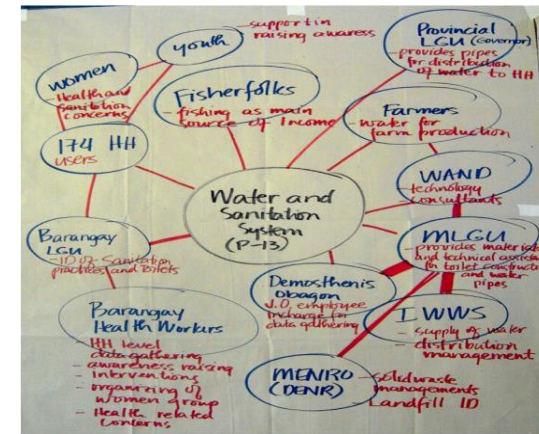

Target groups:

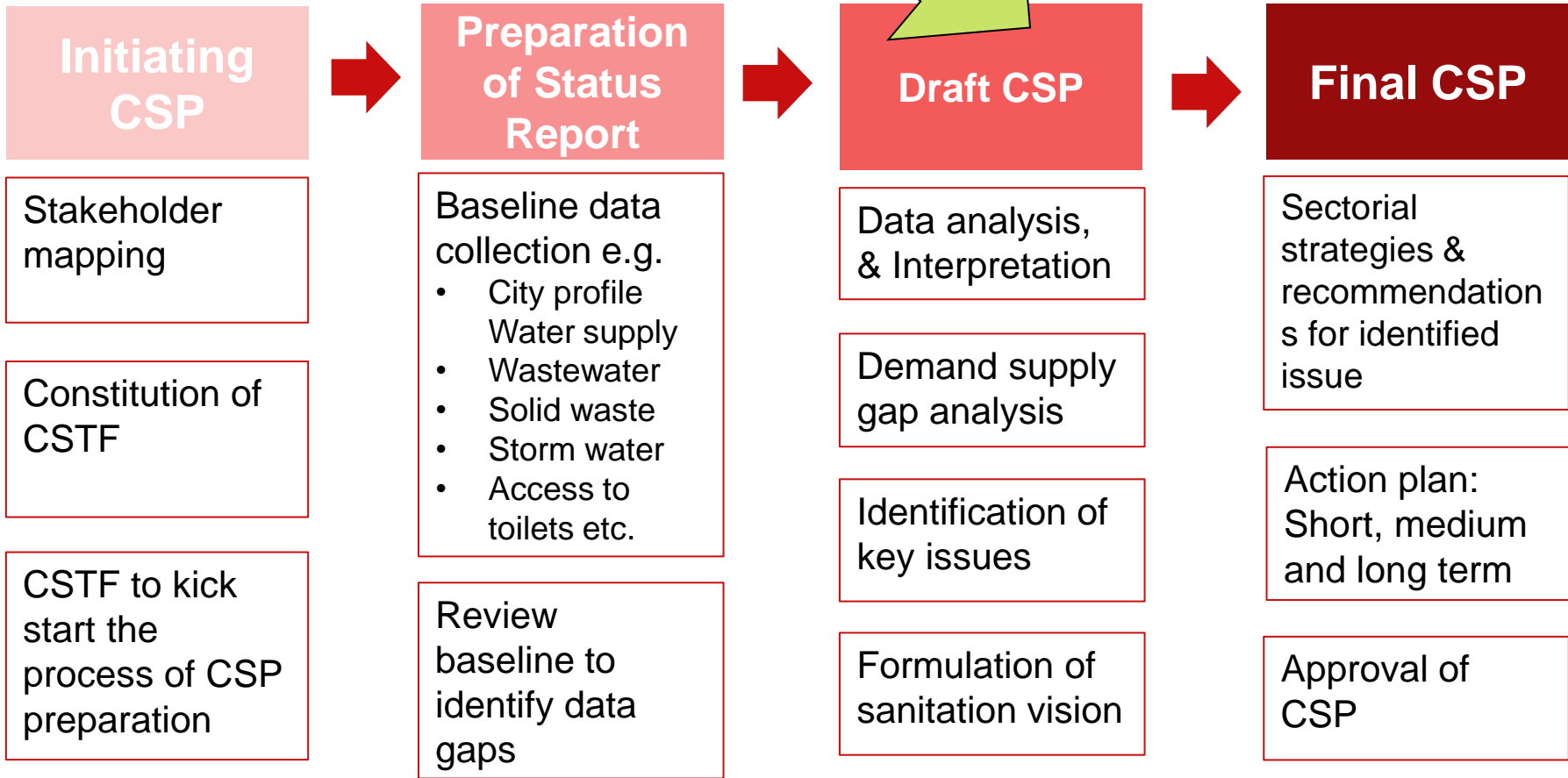
Decision-makers and experts at city and state level confronted with challenges of CSP development and implementation in Telangana, Andhra Pradesh, Kerala and Maharashtra.

Steps in CSP process

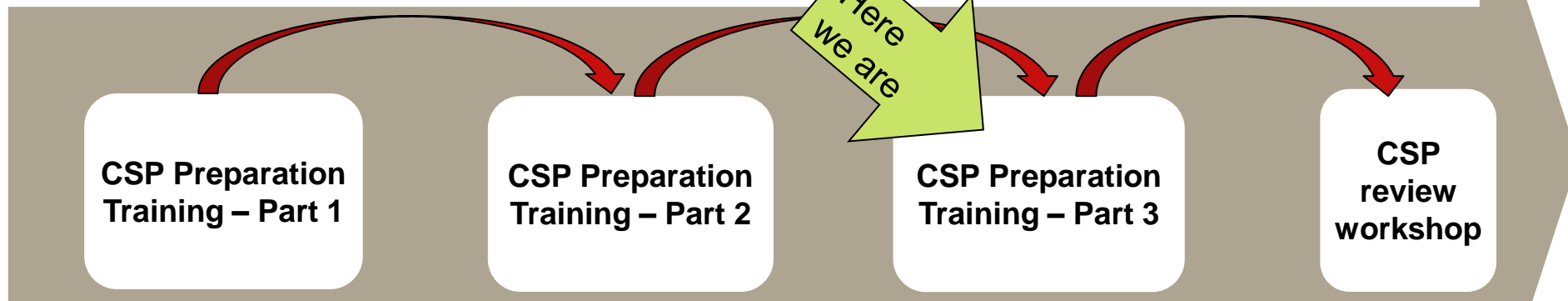

Training programme for CSP preparation process

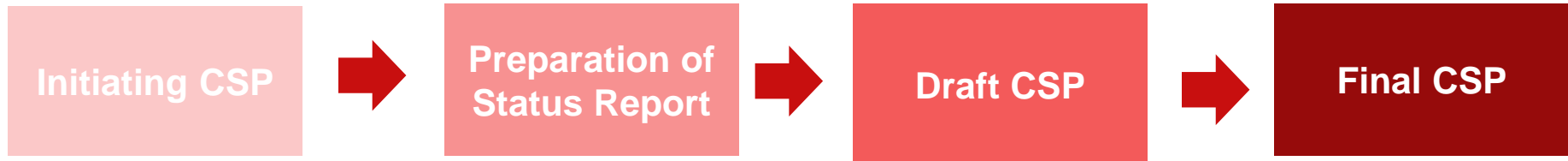

CSP Activities in Andhra Pradesh until now

- **First Training** on CSP Preparation from 1-3 July 2015
- After the Training ULBs were asked for following steps
 - *Formation of CSTF*
 - *Notification on formation of CSTF*
 - *Baseline data collection and compilation of Status Report*
- **Second Training** on CSP preparation from 14-16 of October 2015
- After the Training ULBs were asked to take following steps:
 - *Strengthening of Status Report*
 - *Identification of Key Issues*
 - *Vision formulation with CSTF*
- Workshop for Decision Makers on CSP and Liquid Waste Management, 18th December 2015
- **Third Training** on CSP preparation from 11-13 of April 2016



Achieved Results

- 6 Status Assessment Reports have been submitted in time before the training:
Nandyal, Bhimavaram, Nellore, Elluru, Amalapuram, Kadiri
- Workshop on Liquid Waste Management for Urban Decision Makers on 18th of December 2015

Method of the Training

- Elements: Presentations, Case work, Group work, Action Learning exercises, movies, etc.

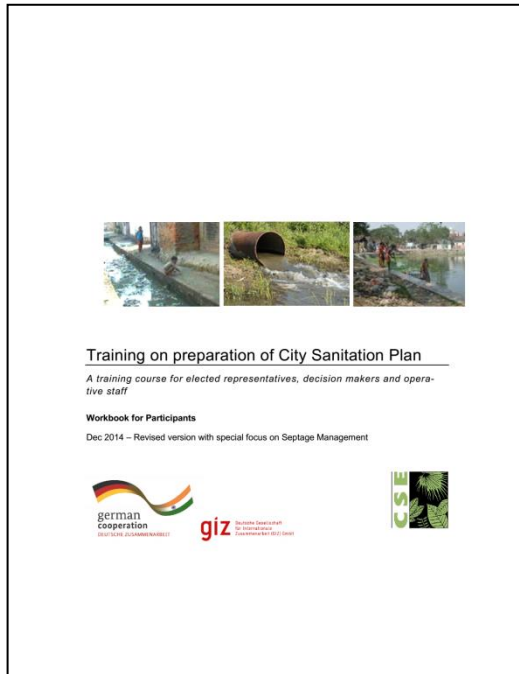
