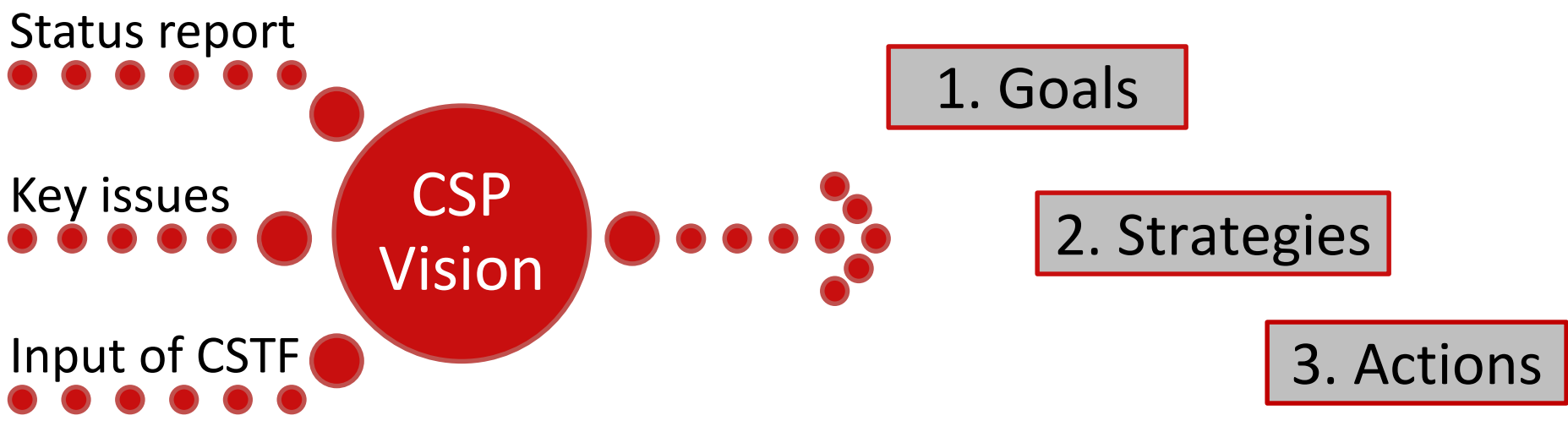

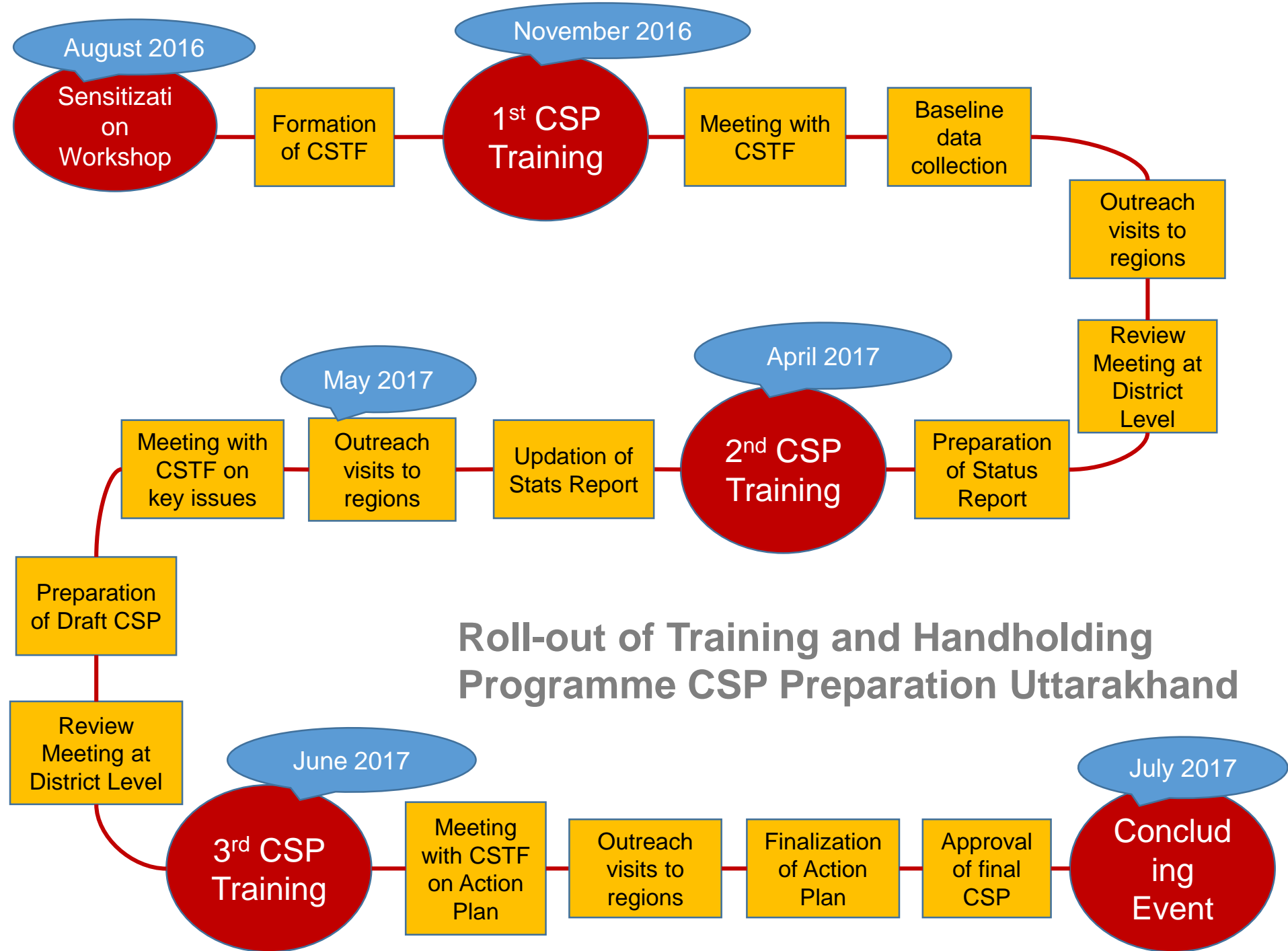


**How would the sanitation

Examples for sanitation visions

- The full sanitation cycle city - The city that uses their liquid and solid waste as a resource
- The participatory city – A city where ULB, NGOs, Council, businesses, citizens and many more stakeholder take the sanitation agenda jointly ahead
- Our city will become a centre for smart sanitation solutions, which will share their experience with other cities and state. It will be the forerunner for septage management in our state.





Tasks for the next phase

Before visit of regional support team:

- Briefing of ULB team, District Magistrate and relevant departments
- Revision / Improvement of Status Report
- Selection and formulation of Key Issues



Tasks for the next phase

During visit of regional support team:

- Organise CSTF Meeting to present Status Report, Key Issues and formulation of sanitation vision
- Finalization of maps
- Bilateral meetings with all relevant departments for answering open questions/improve analysis, if required
- Separate training module on Composting, if required by ULB



Tasks for the next phase

After visit of regional support team:

- Finalization of Draft CSP
- Approval of CSTF of Draft CSP
- Submission of Draft CSP to UDD for technical review
